Are all documents ready? Depending where you come from EU/Non EU and also for safety reasons, make copies of : passport, identity card, driver's license, birth certificate, marriage certificate, health insurance, European health insurance card, A1 certificate, car/vehicle papers, school/graduate certificates, pets identification, special medication prescriptions, medical records. **Register:** Within 5 days at the municipality where you will be located. Also if the address of first stay is temporary. Open a bank account: You need to take passport, BSN, proof of residence, letter confirming employment and/or previous salary slips.
